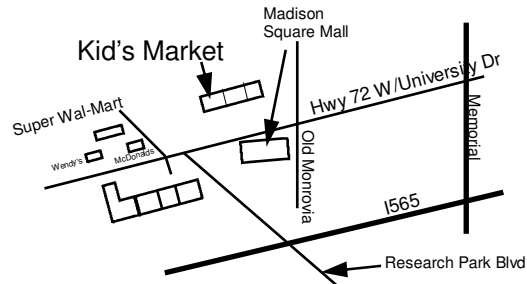

Acceptable Items

- Gently worn, Current style, infant, children, junior, maternity and boys thru size 20; Spring & Summer Clothing
- Dance/Sportswear, holiday wear, Spring: swim wear, Fall: coats and costumes
- Shoes (limit 6 pr. of your best). Sports footwear (must be clean). Tennis shoes must be new looking (due to quantity, unacceptable shoes will not be placed on the sales floor).
- Stuffed mechanical or stuffed educational animals. (Not soft stuffed animals)
- Indoor/Outdoor toys, games, video games, movies, children's books, bikes, skates, sports equipment, etc.
- Clean furniture, bedding, nursery items
- Clean strollers, highchairs, car seats, etc.

Unacceptable Items

(Will not be placed on sales floor)

- Items dirty, **stained**, broken or missing parts. **STAINED ITEMS WILL BE DONATED IMMEDIATELY AND NOT RETURNED TO YOU.**
- Stuffed animals or Beanie Babies
- **Recalled items** - uncorrected. NO RECALLED FURNITURE OR TOYS (They will be discarded and NOT returned to you.)
- Car seats 4 years old or older, or have been in an accident. **Check manufacturing date on the seat. Outdated car seats left at Receiving will be discarded.**
- Battery operated items that have not been tested
- Open pacifiers and nipples
- Misses clothing (Adult styles)
- Items with altered tags—for your protection, make a new tag



Kid's Market accepts checks, Visa, MasterCard and check cards.

Your shopping time is determined by your arrival time at Receiving.

Priority shopping numbers 1-200 are invited to shop Thursday night and may come back and shop Saturday after 1:00. Or, if you do not wish to shop Thursday night, you may shop in number order Saturday morning with the other Contributors.

Only one person per Priority Number

For safety reasons, No children or babies allowed at Worker or Contributor Sales

Tag Template

Just before each sale, we will send an email announcing the sale to all email addresses we have on file. The email will include a link to your Tag Template. You may wish to save this email or link so you will have access to your template in between sales.

If you do not receive the email, you may contact us with your name and mailing address and we will email your template to you, or you may pick up a Tag Template at the store during Tag Template distribution days (see Dates at right).

This template must be copied on **Cardstock** paper to make your tags. Places like Allied Photocopy, Office Depot and Staples will copy this for you if you do not have access to a copier.

You must print the Tag Template on a Laser printer (Not inkjet printer) to print your own tags from the emailed Tag Template. Tags must be printed on **Cardstock** paper.

If you have received a mailing from us in the past and have moved, include your old address, in addition to the new address, with any requests. If it has been more than 3 years since you have sold, please contact us by email to confirm your #.

Receiving

Come early to Receiving to get a low priority shopping number for the Contributor's Sale. Only One Priority Number per Person with a minimum of 15 prepared items.

NOTE: Only 15 items per Contributor will be accepted from 4pm-6pm the final Receiving day.

*Workers

Want to shop before the Contributor's Sale?

Volunteer to work 14 hrs. in a 6-week timeframe and be eligible to shop the Worker's Sale. Now also offering a Part-time Worker option

Contributors

In order to shop as a Contributor, a minimum of 15 items, properly tagged per instructions, must be received by 6pm Monday, during Receiving hours. You keep 2/3 selling price.

Please help us uphold Kid's Market quality. Kid's Market reserves the right to withhold unacceptable items from the sales floor.

NOTE: Stained items will be immediately donated to charity, and will NOT be returned to you.

Pick-up & Pay

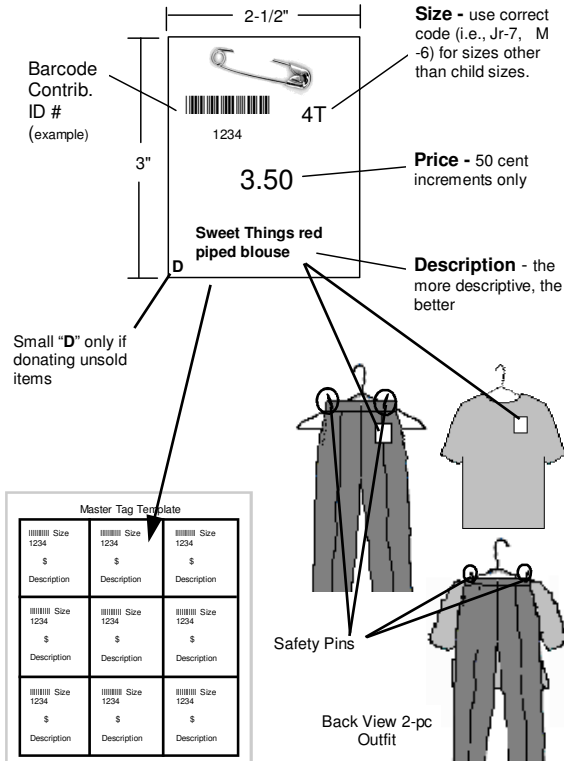
You may have someone pick-up for you, but signed authorization must be provided for them to receive your check, otherwise the check will be mailed. At Receiving, **if you elect to donate your unsold items after the sale, your check will be mailed to you.**

Note

Items cannot be sold without a proper Kid's Market tag with your 4-digit Contributor ID# and barcode provided by us. See Tag Template above.

Examples

Use Tag from your Tag Template, copied or laser printed on Cardstock



General Instructions

Tags: Use tags from Template (provided by Kid's Market) on cardstock paper.

Use black or blue ink for tag information. Use **RED** ink only for the price if you do **not** want the item to sell discounted on the %-off days. Note: If you are donating unsold items, do not price in red.

Place a small "D" on the bottom-left corner of the tags, only if you want to donate the unsold item after the sale.

Prices must be in **50 cent** increments.

Write clearly and neatly. Do not make corrections even with whiteout. Make a new tag.

Trim all tag edges and do not reduce the tag size (2-1/2" x 3")

Clothes: Hang clean clothes on **WIRE hangers** (found at Dry Cleaners or Kid's Market), with hanger hook facing left. **NO plastic coated wire hangers or you will have to cut the plastic off the hook (found at places like Wal-Mart and Kmart). No plastic hangers. No hangers with cardboard.** Do not bend hangers.

We recommend placing a piece of masking tape with just your 4-digit number inside each garment in case tag comes off.

Hang all infant clothes (including onesies), shirts, dresses and jackets on the hanger. Safety pin pants/skirt/shorts at top of waistband to top bar of hanger (see example at left). For two-piece outfits: place shirt on hanger, then safety pin pants/skirt/shorts, thru waistband, to back of shirt at the shoulders supported by hanger.

- Stained items will immediately be donated to charity. They will not be returned to you.
- Use only one hanger for 2 pieces or more as a set.
- Do not hang pants/skirts/shorts underneath shirts.
- Do not put clothes in zip lock bags, hang on a hanger (socks and underwear ok to bag).

Write the size on the tag as a number, not S, M, L, XL. For Children sizes, guess at the size # if you must. If the item fits like a smaller or larger size, write "fits like" then the size it fits like. Use "Jr-"size for junior and "M-"size, for maternity sizes.

Safety pin tag to the right side of the garment using medium or large safety pins, size #1 or #2 (**NO STRAIGHT PINS ALLOWED**, they are dangerous). NO pins smaller than 1-inch. Note: X-large pins leave holes. Do not pin through raincoats, leather, faux leather or suede. (See FAQs online)

Shoes: Limit 6 pair of your best dress shoes or tennis shoes. Tennis shoes **must** be new looking. Mark the bottom of each shoe with your 4-digit Contributor number only (no price) on a piece of masking tape. Attach tag with price securely to shoe or bag, not to the shoebox.

Items: Other than clothes, use clear packing tape or safety pins to attach the tag (same size tag as for clothing) to the item. Use zip lock bags for small pieces. Tape closed. Tape tag to outside of bag.

Write only your 4-digit Contributor ID (no price) on a piece of masking tape and place on the bottom of every large item, in case the tag comes off.

NOTE: NEVER put two tags on one item. Never write a price on the item, only on the Kid's Market tag.

NOTE:

- * **STAINED ITEMS WILL BE DONATED IMMEDIATELY AS THEY ARE FOUND, NOT RETURNED TO YOU.**
- * No STUFFED ANIMALS or Beanie Babies.
- * Do NOT put clothes in zip lock bags.
- * Do NOT tape tags inside zip lock bags.
- * No cardboard hangers. Plain, bare-metal hangers only.
- * Write "D" on tag if donating (see tag above).
- * No safety pins smaller than 1-inch.
- * **No recalled items**

Bundling Examples:

Tie off all your size 4 girl clothes. Separately tie off all size 4T girl clothes. Size 8-10 clothes are bundled as a group. Size 8 clothes are bundled together. Size 10 clothes are bundled together, etc.

There is a designated space for every size. If you have only one of a size, leave it separate.

Final Preparation: For Receiving, separate, tie-off and label clothes by sex then by size. Clothing **MUST** be tied-off by size!

Tie together prepared clothes into bundles using string, ribbon or twist ties. Separate by size and boys from girls before tying. Clothing **MUST** be bundled by size! Each size is different. (i.e., 4T and 4 are different, 10/11 is different from a 10, 24 mo and 2T are different). One of a size leave by itself.

Dance/sportswear, holiday wear, coats (seasonal), costumes (seasonal) and swimwear (seasonal) may be bundled together, according to grouping rather than size. They are placed in special areas on the sales floor. Please mark these bundles.

Drop Off: Group same items in plastic shopping bags for drop-off. **Please bag only like items together** (i.e., bag shoes in one, toys in one, bottles in one, movies in one, books in one, etc.). Bags may then be brought in a box or plastic tub. Do not bring loose items in plastic tubs or boxes that must be "dumped" and returned to you. You will be asked to sort and separate bags/boxes of **mixed** items.
